Introduction to Feng Shui

Feng Shui is an ancient Chinese art and science studying how the environment affects human well being and prosperity. Various kinds of natural forces and energies exist in the environment; some of these energies are positive and will enhance your well-being and prosperity and some are negative disrupting the harmony. These energies are otherwise known as water and mountain stars and are dynamic and change their position every twenty years (the current age of 8 runs from 2004 – 2024).

The water and mountain stars affect the human well being and prosperity of the people living or working in a space. They are calculated using The Flying Star Chart and are represented by numbers 1 to 9. Each number translates to where the positive and negative energy of human harmony and prosperity falls in a space. These numbers also correspond to the 5 elements; earth, metal, water, wood, and fire. The essence of Feng Shui is where the numbers 1 to 9 fall and the inter-relationship between the 5 elements.

The numbers in green on the floor plan refer to the mountain stars affecting human harmony (health and relationship); these are quiet stars. The red numbers are the water stars affecting your prosperity (wealth) and are the active stars.

The positive energy for the current age of 8 runs from 2004 to 2024 and is represented by numbers 8, 9 and to a lesser extent number 1.

Introduction to Form School

Form School is assessing the surrounding landscape such as hills and objects and other buildings in relation to the position of the space. Ideally you want the building to be surrounded by mountains / hills at the back and the left and right side of the building with a body of water or open space in front. In the near distance in the front of the building a smaller hill has a positive effect by stopping the energy dispersing.

Take note that Form School does not have as much impact on the energy of a space as the Flying Star Chart does.

Introduction to Four Pillars of Destiny

The Four Pillar formula is derived from birth data including the year, month, day and hour a person is born. This information determines what element a person is such as Weak Metal for example and their pattern of luck over their life time. This information allows you to determine what colors and objects should surround them in their home and office to achieve a balanced Four Pillars.
